SCHIZOPHRENIA IN TWO WORDS

Approximately one in a hundred people suffers from schizophrenia. In 85% of cases, schizophrenia begins between 15 and 25 years of age

Symptoms of schizophrenia

- Delusions and abnormal behaviour
- Auditory hallucinations, talking-to-oneseft
- Thought and speech disorders
- Tendency for social isolation

Schizophrenia can be treated

- Early treatment can improve recovery
- In about 80% of the cases, symptoms improve when treatment begins
- Schizophrenia is treated in outpatient settings
- Family and friends play an important role in the life and treatment of a loved one who has schizophrenia
